

Itinerary - FMA Trip to New York

Dress: Saturday and Sunday are casual days, but good walking shoes and a light jacket are recommended. Monday and Tuesday are professional dress days. Coat or suit with orange tie for men. Pantsuit, suit or dress with an orange shirt or scarf for ladies. Comfortable, closed-toe shoes a must!

Silence cell phones. Bring photo I.D., but do not bring liquids (coffee, bottled water) into any buildings. Bring itinerary, map of New York and list of cell phone numbers. You are responsible for getting yourself to each location ON TIME! After your arrival at the hotel on Saturday, go to a subway station and purchase a 7-day, unlimited use subway card so you'll be ready to get on the train with the group.
